Broadway Stars Take Center Stage at Lakes Area Music Festival Gala

Meghan Picerno and Andrea Ross join conductor Christian Reif and the LAMF Symphony for an unforgettable night of music and celebration, kicking off the Festival's 17th season.

Brainerd, MN (July 21, 2025) – With just days to go before the curtain rises, excitement is building for Spellbound—the Lakes Area Music Festival's dazzling Gala and the official kickoff to its 17th season. Taking place Friday, July 25 at the Gichi-ziibi Center for the Arts, this one-night-only event features Broadway powerhouses Meghan Picerno (*The Phantom of the Opera*) and Andrea Ross (*The Sound of Music*), joined by conductor Christian Reif and the Lakes Area Music Festival Symphony Orchestra.

Meghan Picerno, known for her radiant voice and commanding stage presence, shared her excitement about performing "Glitter and Be Gay" from Bernstein's *Candide*—a signature role she's performed to acclaim across the country. "Christian and I have dreamed of performing this together for years, and now it's finally happening," she said. "It's going to sparkle!"

Andrea Ross, whose theatrical credits include international tours and recordings with Andrew Lloyd Webber, expressed her joy at returning to LAMF: "There's always a bit of magic in the air on Gala night. This year, with songs from Broadway, Disney, and fairy tales, I'm thrilled to bring that enchantment to the stage—and I plan to *Wicked*-ly enjoy every second."

The mainstage performance begins at 8:00 p.m. and will serve as a vibrant celebration of the talent, generosity, and community spirit that powers LAMF all season long. Proceeds from the Gala support the Festival's year-round concerts, youth education programs, and community engagement initiatives.
